This position is integral to maintaining safe, functional, and well-presented school facilities, enhancing the overall learning environment for students and staff.

Key Responsibilities

Compliance and Equipment Testing

- Portable Appliance Testing (PAT): Conduct PAT testing on electrical appliances to ensure compliance with safety standards. Accurately record results, identify issues, and report concerns to the Facilities and Compliance Manager.
- Legionella Testing: Perform regular legionella testing, including flushing low-use outlets, measuring temperatures, and maintaining accurate records in accordance with health and safety guidelines. Promptly report irregularities or concerns.
