MAIN DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Operational

1. To maintain a caring and professional attitude towards children, families, and other team members always

4. To provide support to the Nursery School team with direct care of the nursery children
5. To report any faulty equipment to the deputy head
6. To adhere to all the Council and Nursery School policies including equal opportunities and diversity
7. To maintain and be responsible for health and safety within the working environment
8. To assist with stock taking and ordering of disposable goods and foods as required
9. To assist the Nursery in food hygiene monitoring systems such as temperature controls and checks
10. To set up the tables and chairs for the children's meal times
11. To hygienically prepare food, drinks and tables for snacks, lunch, and tea for the children
12. To tidy and clean all tables chairs and floors after meals and be responsible for washing up and maintaining hygiene of equipment regarding this
13. To ensure that the laundry is done and hygiene room is kept clean and tidy
14. To ensure any children's dirty clothing is washed out, bagged, and labelled to go home
15. To assist the team in maintaining cleanliness and tidiness of resources and rooms
