Purpose of the job:

To meet the aims of the school by co-leading the External Leadership Programme for residential students from the age of 9-16+ years. With the assistance of other staff members provide an environment in which the needs of the students with SEMH can be met and to promote the physical, social, emotional and intellectual needs of students, preparing students to become independent individuals.

Major duties and responsibilities.

- 1. As the Outdoor Education Instructor maintain professional standards and offer appropriate modelling to students at all times.
- 2. Assist in organising the External Leadership programme which includes the 24hour curriculum.
- 3. To act as co-ordinator for any activity centres used by the school.
- 4. To co-ordinate KS4 outward bounds based accreditation.
- 5. To complete EVOLVE Risk Assessments.
- 6. Assist in organising and attend a number of camps annually.
- 7. To actively contribute to staff meetings.
- 8. To participate fully and as appropriate in training opportunities provided by the school.

Job Activities:

- 1. Responsible for the health and welfare of all the students.
- 2. To be responsible for the upkeep of any equipment and to generally maintain the outdoor activity programme.
- 3. To resolve conflict in a calm assured manner ensuring the students welfare is foremost.
- 4. Manage, organise and supervise recreational activities and outings including to participate in, and encourage students to participate in such activities.
- 5. Responsible for the writing of reports for annual reviews and end of term.
- 6. To attend regular weekly team meetings to discuss standards, quality and consistency of emotional and physical care for students
- 7. Establish and maintain good working relationships with all staff groups.
