We are based at Phoenix Special School, providing a unique opportunity to link outstanding specialist teaching and support with inclusive mainstream settings.

You will be joining an Outstanding School (Ofsted November 2018) with strong leadership and a committed staff team. Phoenix School is successful, ambitious and forward-thinking. Pupils are aged between 3 and 19 and make very good progress with access to an enriching curriculum.

We are an award-winning school and accredited through the National Autistic Society; praised for our creative approach to working with children with autism.

The Phoenix Outreach Service supports over 100 settings, including nurseries, primary and secondary schools. There are approximately 700 pupils on our service caseload aged between 3 and 19. Tower Hamlets is renowned as a borough with a very inclusive ethos, and these values are evident in the schools that we support.

You will be working in a position across a range of primary and secondary school settings, to support inclusive teaching practice and cultures. Among other things, the role involves direct work with pupils, curriculum planning with teachers, devising behaviour support plans, and providing training for parents and professionals. It is a varied and exciting role, so the successful candidate will need to work flexibly and creatively.
