Chilton School is a large and popular village school set on the outskirts of Chilton at the foot of the Berkshire Downs. The main school building was built in 2002 and is surrounded by extensive grounds. In 2018 we added a new three-class extension.

We have an intake of 45 children into our Reception classes. We operate mixed aged classes in Key Stage 1 and lower Key Stage 2. Upper Key Stage 2 remains single form entry until the school grows to its full capacity.

Chilton is a friendly and high achieving school. We use our core values to underpin a curriculum that puts the child at the centre of our school, where positive relationships, based on mutual trust and respect are at the heart of everything we do.

Our ambitious curriculum has been designed to take account of the legal requirements of the Early Years Foundation Stage Curriculum and the Primary National Curriculum. It exposes our children to enriching experiences, immersing them in progressive knowledge and skills; equipping them with personal characteristics required to succeed in life.

Our cross-curricular approach to learning allows the children to engage in imaginative and creative topics. We place high value on outdoor learning and have an onsite Forest School where children are offered exciting experiences all year round. Our well-tended school garden, the size of an allotment, enables the children to grow their own fruit and vegetables.

Educational and residential visits are encouraged and carefully chosen to deepen understanding.
