- Show that they have experience in teaching in Key Stage 2 preferably in mixed age classes
- Demonstrate high expectations and has an excellent knowledge of the curriculum
- Display good communication skills
- Demonstrate good planning, assessment and recording methods
- Use computing and other areas of ICT to support learning
- Cooperate and liaise closely with parents and carers, professional colleagues within the school and those from external agencies
- Liaise with other Key Stage 2 staff to ensure consistence and continuity for all pupils.
