Requirements

The position is a part time (0.44 FTE) maternity cover to work with a very happy, hardworking and well-behaved class of Year 2 children. We hope the successful candidate will join us from 1st January 2023 and be able to come in for some transition time before Christmas. There is potential for this role to become permanent.

You will be undertaking a job-share with an experienced teacher in Year 2, and work alongside a full-time partner teacher in the other Year 2 class. All the Year 2 teachers have joint PPA time on a Wednesday afternoon, so the successful candidate will be paid to take part in this shared planning time at school. In addition, you will have the support of a highly trained full time TA, who will be with the class all week.
