Main purpose

The teacher will:

- Fulfil the professional responsibilities of a teacher, as set out in the School Teachers' Pay and Conditions Document
- Meet the expectations set out in the Teachers' Standards

Key Responsibilities

- **Curriculum Delivery:** Plan and deliver high-quality, engaging music lessons for pupils from Reception to Year 6, ensuring music remains a core part of the school curriculum.
- **Teaching & Learning:** Set high expectations to inspire and motivate pupils. Assess and report on progress while maintaining a positive, well-managed classroom environment.
- **Professional Development:** Proactively engage in professional training (INSET) and keep up to date with current primary music pedagogy and curriculum standards.
- **Communication:** Work collaboratively with the staff team, communicate effectively with parents regarding pupil progress, and liaise with external music partners and hubs.
- **School Life:** Lead musical performances, assemblies, and extra-curricular groups (e.g., choir) to maintain the school's excellent musical reputation.

The teacher will be required to safeguard and promote the welfare of children and young people and follow school policies and the staff code of conduct.
