Job Purpose

- To organise and manage groups or individual pupils ensuring differentiation of learning needs, reflecting all abilities.
- Contribute to the development and co-ordination of the Music Curriculum.
- To be an active leader of Music provision, being involved in decision-making on the preparation and development of programmes of study, teaching materials, resources and methods of teaching.
- To promote the welfare of children and to support the school in safeguarding children through relevant policies and procedures.
