The majority of children transfer from our nursery and are joined in Reception by children from other settings. At the end of Key Stage One most children transfer to Sawley Junior School, which is on our shared site.

Our school initially converted to an academy in 2014 with three local schools and recently we merged with another multi academy trust. ONE Academy Trust is a collection of eight good and outstanding schools across Derbyshire and Nottinghamshire with shared values and individual school characters. There are many opportunities for collaboration as we draw upon our collective experiences, talents and resources, including cluster working groups for professional development and a strong partnership development programme. One Academy Trust operate standard teachers' pay and conditions and honour continuous service from local authority employment.
