Post: Part Time Peripatetic Music Tutor

Purpose

To challenge educational and social disadvantage by providing music tutoring in order to achieve the highest possible standards and prepare all our students to lead successful lives.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Plan and deliver high quality instruments to individuals and groups of students.
- Plan and direct high quality ensembles as directed by the Head of Music.
- Prepare students for external performance examinations such as GCSE, A level and ABRSM or similar.
- Prepare individuals and ensembles for academy concerts and other events on a regular basis and attend these concerts as an ambassador for the Music Department as requested by the Head of Music.
- Select and / or arrange musical repertoire according to the needs of students.
- Engage fully in the academy appraisal process to fulfil personal potential and be able to participate effectively in the implementation of the academy's goals and improvement plan.
- Attend meetings / training and carry out administrative tasks and duties as specified by the Head of Music - this will include the creation of a student timetable which is effectively rotated and submission of student reports as per the academy calendar.
- Consistently implement all academy policies.
- Report any safeguarding concerns immediately to a Designated Safeguarding Lead.
- Carry out any other reasonable duties as requested by the Principal.
