Overall purpose of job:	
The core focus of this job is to assist with supporting the school with the provision of extended care. The post holder will do this by supervising children and organising activities.	
Main duties and responsibilities:	
1.	Plan and deliver a variety of safe, creative and appropriate play opportunities for the children at the clubs
2.	Prepare and provide healthy snacks/refreshments to the children following food hygiene practices, and clean up afterwards
3.	Prepare and set up room(s) as required
4.	Administer basic first aid as required
5.	Undertake the personal care of children as required, including toileting, dressing, dealing with sickness
6.	Ensure children are supervised at all times
7.	Ensure the building is safe and secure for the children at all times
8.	Ensures play equipment and materials are properly used, maintained and stored and report any damages or issues to the KCKC Manager
9.	Maintain accurate records as required, to include completion of accident book records, registers of attendance, and up to date emergency contact details

1.	Uphold professional standards for the role, and follow all school and Trust policies and procedures.
2.	Comply with Child Safeguarding Procedures and adhere to the Trust's Child Protection and Safeguarding Policy at all times.

3.	Participate in performance management and take part in appropriate training and development activities.
