Primary Music Teacher

This is a great opportunity for a teacher with a passion in teaching music to children. The successful candidate will be a strong practitioner and team player. They will have a good understanding of the national curriculum and children's learning in the EYFS. The successful candidate can negotiate a TLR and be part of the school's curriculum leadership team.

The role involves the teaching of music across the school. This will include singing, percussion and possibly an instrument. There will be good provision for CPD and training for the post-holder.

Full-time applicants will teach music in the afternoons and provide support for core subjects in the morning in a Year group (playing to their strength). Part-time will involve teaching music 3 to 5 afternoons depending on availability.
