The salary for this role starts from £16,000 p/a and is dependent upon experience. You should have a good all round education. It is essential that you have at least some exposure to working in a Primary Education environment; have an awareness and understanding of classroom roles and responsibilities; and experience of working with or caring for children of relevant age.
