The Principal will provide effective professional leadership, developing and promoting a shared vision and strategic plan, instilling a culture that focuses on excellence, equality and high expectations for all Plume students, staff and other stakeholders.

Personal Qualities

The successful applicant should have a good honours degree and a QTS or equivalent teaching qualification and have proven successful experience of outstanding leadership within a secondary setting and hold the NPQH qualification.

Applicants should be hardworking, enthusiastic and have a high level of commitment and ability to focus on fostering the teaching, learning and personal development of Year 7 to 13 students. They should have an interest in new teaching and learning developments, a high level of integrity and desire to visibly lead the Academy which sits in the heart of the vibrant Maldon Community. Experienced candidates should be able to evidence excellent school wide levels of value-added achievement and high retention levels.

Remuneration

Annual salary for a qualified teacher will be in accordance with the academy Teachers Pay Scale, which from appointment for a full time post currently involves a salary within the leadership pay scale of L36 – L41 (£104,696 – £118,293) (2022/23 pay awards) - Negotiable, however, current salary of the applicant will be taken into consideration for salary offered. Salaries are reviewed by national negotiation with effect from 1st September each year. Progression through the Teachers Pay Scale is subject to acceptable annual performance development review process.
