Thank you for your enquiry regarding the post of Reading Ambassador/Level 3 Specialist Teaching Assistant. This is an existing post designed to support the effective teaching and learning across the academy.

We are a high-performing, SEMH special school which was judged as Outstanding in every area by Ofsted in June 2023. We are not remotely complacent about this and are committed to ensuring that the quality of provision we offer to our students is consistently excellent.
