Job Purpose:	To provide full technician support to science teaching staff, particularly in the preparation and cleaning/clearing of lesson materials.		
Principal Accountabilities:	 To ensure the efficient preparation and organisation of equipment and resources for lessons as required. To clean equipment after each practical lesson. 		
Duties:	 To ensure safe storage and use of laboratory equipment, including chemicals where necessary. To ensure that equipment and resources are provided for lessons as ordered in advance by science teachers. To refer stock requirements to the Senior Science Technician. To undertake science photocopying as required. To clean equipment after practical lessons. To liaise with caretaking staff regarding any gas/fume/health and safety problems that may occur. To ensure the application of Health and Safety procedures and to raise awareness of H&S issues specifically in relation to laboratories. To assist in ensuring the safe conduct of pupils in the department. 		
General	 To undertake any training commensurate with the post. To participate in the performance and development review process, taking personal responsibility for identification of learning, development and training opportunities in discussion with line manager.
