JOB DESCRIPTION

Job Title: Science Technician

Accountable to: Senior Science Technician

Main purpose of the role:

To provide equipment and resources for demonstration, class practical work, assessments and examinations whilst also supporting the wider functioning of the science department. To work closely with all staff across the department, ensuring that they deliver the necessary support to facilitate high-quality teaching and learning in science.

Responsibilities:

- Construct and modify apparatus within the limits of the changing curriculum
- Keep up to date with health and safety requirements and with developments in practical science from CLEAPSS & COSHH
- Prepare standard solutions, treat and dispose of waste materials.
- Run safety checks on equipment that require them.
- Perform checks on standard equipment stored in the labs ie, Bunsen burners, goggles etc.
- Set up and care for plant collections.
- Assist in the checking of goods delivered against orders and in carrying out inventory checks on a regular basis
- Assist in designing of experiments/practicals that fulfil the needs of the curriculum
- Run and report on results of trial experiments
- Assist the Head of Department in other duties as appropriate, such as numbering and repairing textbooks, organising reprographics, assisting in preparation for Open Evenings
- To support staff in their day to day tasks
- To support the senior technician with administering cover
- Assist in the provision and setting up of all equipment and resources for practical sessions and examinations as required.
- Prepare resources, assemble apparatus.
- Maintain and repair the apparatus/equipment used by the department and report other damages/needs
- Maintenance of specialist apparatus/equipment, check apparatus/equipment and ensure that health and safety guidelines are adhered to.
- Operate relevant equipment/ICT packages (e.g. MS Office, internet, E-mail, photographic equipment)
- Report any damage/issues to the Senior technician
- Maintain tidy and organised work spaces and storage areas
- Give technical and health and safety advice to teachers and students.
