DUTIES

Stock Control and Maintenance

- Maintain, modify, and manage stock control of equipment, chemicals, and perishables.
- Prepare and clean apparatus for practical lessons and experiments.
- Assist in testing new experiments and maintaining ongoing experiments.
- Keep inventory and purchase items as instructed.

Support & Deliver Learning – Supporting Teachers

- Prepare lesson materials, collect apparatus, and set up equipment for practical lessons.
- Assist in demonstrations and practical sessions as requested.
- Communicate with staff regarding equipment use and safety.
- Maintain stocks of materials and assist in purchasing.
- Ensure proper storage and disposal of chemicals and waste materials.

Laboratory Maintenance

- Keep laboratories clean, tidy, and safe.
- Clean equipment, benches, and sinks regularly.
- Update safety manuals and conduct safety checks.
- Manage stock and replace items as needed.
- Participate in professional development activities as required.
