ENGLISH

The department comprises 6 full-time members of staff, and is situated in purpose-built classrooms, with all rooms benefiting from projectors, visualisers and interactive whiteboards. English is a popular subject in the school, and results have followed an upward trend in recent years.

At GCSE, the department follows the AQA specification for both Language and Literature. At Key Stage 3 and 4, we utilise the Redhill Trust 5 year scheme of learning which incorporates a wide range of texts; resources and teaching strategies to maximise pupil progress, as well as to facilitate analytical thinking and engender a passion for Literature.

Working closely with the Trust Director for English allows for consistency in assessments and interventions across Trust schools, as well as high quality CPD and shared resources. 'English Trust Resource Shares' are great events and an opportunity to collaborate and share best practice with colleagues from across the Trust.

Students have 3 hours of English lessons per week in years 7 and 8, as well as an additional dedicated hour for the Accelerated Reader programme. Some students also have an additional hour to improve literacy skills dependent on setting. In year 9 students have 4 hours of English per week, increasing to 5 hours in years 10 and 11. Those students requiring extra support take part in small-group intervention work or attend our popular English period 6 sessions.
