- experience working with autistic children or adults with a good understanding of the possible associated strengths and challenges
- good Maths and English skills sufficient to support the KS2 curriculum
- the ability to support and run interventions to support social understanding, communication and emotional development
- be able to engage well with other teaching staff, other professionals involved and maintain good communication with the family in order to successfully deliver the requirements of the child’s Education Health and Care Plan (EHCP).

It would be an advantage, but not essential to have experience delivering or supporting ELSA interventions, sensory circuits, visual timetables and other relevant tools, as required by the EHCP.

This role offers a rewarding opportunity to make a real difference and in return gain further experience and development working in a SEN role within a small friendly village school.
