You will be on the Leadership Team with responsibility for the strategic and operational oversight of our SEND policy and provision.

The post includes a part-time teaching commitment of up to 2 days in total a week – for example, leadership cover and/or leading SEND pupil interventions.

Please note that only candidates who have the NASENCO qualification or are currently partially way through the NASENCO will be shortlisted.
