Main Purpose of Job

- 1. To work one to one with a child with Special Educational Needs, supporting their learning and development in line with the EYFS and their individual education plan.
- 2. To work under the guidance of the class teacher, keyworker and SENCo to support the child's teaching and learning
- 3. To provide general support to the class teacher in the management and organisation of the pupils and the classroom
- 4. To assist the class teacher in creating and maintaining a purposeful, orderly and supportive learning environment
- 5. To promote the inclusion of all pupils ensuring they have equal access to opportunities to learn and develop
- 6. To be responsible for promoting and safeguarding the welfare of children and young people within the school

Main Responsibilities

Support for the Pupils

- To work with a child with SEN and to take responsibility for their learning
- To support a child with disabilities or special educational needs
- To support the care and hygiene requirements for a child with SEN
- To provide support for the children to broaden and enrich their learning
- To work with the SENCO and other teachers to develop and implement IEPs
- To understand the individual needs of children and be responsible for supporting re social interactions health and hygiene
- To promote the inclusion and acceptance of all pupils within the classroom. Encourage pupils to interact and work co-operatively with others and engage in all activities
- To provide feedback to pupils in relation to progress and achievement.
- To establish and develop productive working relationships with pupils acting as a role model
- To work with pupils, understanding how to motivate and encourage them to develop and achieve
- To support children in ensuring that they understand tasks and learning objectives

Support for the Teachers

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- Within an agreed system of supervision, to work with the teacher to develop activities, work plans and the classroom environment
- To assess, feedback and record the achievements and progress of pupils through agreed monitoring systems
- To establish and maintain constructive relationships with parents/carers by:
 - -supporting their role in their child's learning
 - -providing constructive feedback on their child's progress and achievements
 - -facilitating their support for their child's attendance
 - -support home to school/community links
- To be proactive in managing behaviour and promote self-control, independence and integration
- To support pupil transitions and attend parents meetings as appropriate
- To accompany teachers and classes on educational visits
- To work with the class teacher to complete administration tasks

- To contribute to overall ethos/work/aims of the school
- To attend and participate in regular meetings, and in training and other activities as required
- To assist in the general care of the school environment
- To engage in the appraisal system for support staff

Support for the Curriculum

- In line with planning, deliver learning and teaching activities and adjust these when necessary
- To be responsible for management of stock levels and for maintenance / quality /safety of specialist equipment
- To use and prepare specialist equipment, plans and resources necessary to support learning activities, taking into account pupil's interests, language and cultural backgrounds
- To assist with the development of the Early Years Foundation Stage
- To undertake broadly similar duties commensurate with the level of the post as required by the Head teacher
