You should have proven experience of working with primary school aged children, ideally as a Teaching Assistant, and have good all-round literacy and numeracy, with at least NVQ2 or equivalent qualifications in both English and Maths. You should have a calm and empathetic approach, a good sense of humour, be able to demonstrate enthusiasm for all teaching and learning activities and always maintain confidentiality. Training in or experience of delivering phonics and of supporting writing would be advantageous. Experience of working within an Early Years environment would be beneficial.
