- Attend meetings / training and carry out administrative tasks and duties as specified by the head of music - this will include the creation of a student timetable which is effectively rotated and submission of student reports as per the academy calendar.
- Consistently implement all trust policies and contribute to decision-making and consultation procedures.
- Report any safeguarding concerns immediately to a designated safeguarding lead.
- Carry out any other reasonable duties as requested by the principal.
