Our SENDCo will have overall responsibility for provision for students with special educational needs and disabilities; they will run a growing team of committed learning support assistants and lead the direction and quality of teaching and learning in this key area. Teachers of any subject area, from either secondary or primary background are invited to apply. We are a new and growing school and this is an exciting opportunity for an outstanding teacher who aspires to whole school leadership in a role that will eventually lead provision for students from ages 4-16. Potential is as important as experience. This role will be supported by the senior leadership team and will benefit from experienced cross trust leadership.
