Post Title – Music teacher

The roles and responsibilities of a main scale teacher apply to this post.

Prime Role of the Post

The main role of the specialist music teacher is, as well as teaching the national curriculum requirements for music, to give pupils across the school a passion for music and to ensure that music is at the heart of our school culture.

Main responsibilities of the post

Teach whole class music weekly to R, Y1 and Y2 including planning, teaching and assessment.

Cover PPA in KS2 through teaching specialist music teaching to KS2 classes.

Lead KS2 Singing Assembly.

Run a weekly after school choir/s preparing for events in school and out of school.

Run orchestra after school weekly, supported by a TA.

Co-ordinate the visiting instrumental teachers.

Prepare children for specific events such as Outreach Projects, Singing Festivals etc. and accompany them to the event.

Support the class teachers with musical productions.

Support class teachers with assemblies etc for specific events, such as Harvest.

A suitable candidate would really need to be able to play the piano.
