In this role, you will have the opportunity to make a real impact on the lives of our children, helping them to develop their physical skills and fitness, as well as their self-confidence and self-esteem. We follow a crucial knowledge based curriculum where children take part in a wide range of physical activity to enable them to develop their health, fitness, personal and social skills whilst also promoting self-confidence, cooperation, team work and self-esteem. The links with the Science curriculum are clear and PE gives a clear context and opportunity to apply the knowledge they have gained about the human body.

The successful candidate will be responsible for the following:

- Preparing, delivering and evaluating well-structured and progressive physical activity sessions programmes (years 1-6)
- Delivering the Physical Education National Curriculum to primary school children
- Effective teaching and behaviour management strategies during your lessons
- Identifying and overcoming barriers to participation, prioritising access and inclusion
- Being a positive role model and creating a positive and fun environment for children to participate in sport and physical activity
- Participation in events which are offered to us
- Delivering playground sports leadership training for pupils
