- coordinate KS3, 4 5 assessments and the recording of associated data
- support the development of very able linguists and students with Special Educational Needs
- support members of the department in upholding high standards of behaviour in MFL lessons by playing a key role in the MFL discipline procedure
- manage, support and train new staff
- work closely with the Head of MFL to ensure consistency of standards within the department
- create and provide extra curricular activities to promote the subject
