

ECT EYFS Class Teacher Job Description

A classroom teacher will be responsible for the following main tasks:

- 1. To carry out duties of a school teacher as set out in the current School Teachers' Pay and Conditions Document and ensure that the Teachers' Standards are met.
- 2. To be an effective, successful and creative teacher, catering for the needs of the children in the class.
- 3. To teach within the school's curriculum, schemes of work and policies
- 4. To plan and prepare lessons which challenge and inspire the children
- 5. To regularly assess pupils' performance and progress and use this to inform teaching
- 6. To provide regular feedback to the children
- 7. To implement the school's behaviour policy in a consistent manner
- 8. To support the personal development of children offering guidance and support where needed
- 9. To establish and maintain good relationships with children, parents and colleagues in line with the principles of inclusion.
- 10. To liaise effectively with parents, giving feedback and encouraging parents to support their children at home.
- 11. To collaborate with other staff in the development of our whole school curriculum
- 12. To recognise the individual needs of each child within the class and liaise with outside agencies where required.
- 13. To actively participate in the ECT induction attending all online and face to face meetings. Meet regularly with mentor to ensure strong progress through the ECT programme.
- 14. To participate in continuous professional development to enhance teaching
- 15. To share responsibility for the welfare and safety of all the children in the care of the school.
- 16. To undertake any other suitable duties that the Headteacher may require from time to time.
