Context:

We are a Complex Needs School for 188 from September 2025, with moderate, severe or profound learning difficulties between the ages of 3 to 19. All pupils have different learning needs; they learn best when they are happy and excited about learning.

All our pupils have a wide range of special and additional needs; pupils may have moderate to severe learning difficulties or profound and multiple learning needs with significant sensory impairment or medical needs. A high proportion of our pupils have autistic spectrum disorder.

We use a range of specialist resources, including a hydrotherapy pool, multi-sensory rooms, specialist hoisting, standing, walking and seating resources and bespoke outdoor play equipment. Currently we operate four minibuses.

Your role:

We are seeking a teacher to teach 8-9 pupils. You will be supported in class by experienced teaching assistants and you will work alongside a team of dedicated teachers.

You will be teaching a highly adapted and modified curriculum in an exciting and creative way so that all young people engage with you and learn as well as they possibly can. All of your assessment and planning will be highly individualised to meet the specific needs of each pupil. All pupils follow a bespoke curriculum that include independence and life skills, social and communication skills and learning within our local community. Our older pupils have access to our school shop in the centre of Attleborough, to gain valuable experience within the community and all pupils have access to the school minibuses for educational visits to enhance learning.

The pupils in your class will have a wide range of profound and multiple learning disabilities. You will receive a very focussed induction training and a mentor (experienced teacher) will support you. Our school is very committed to develop the knowledge and skills of all staff and you are expected to engage in a wide range of professional development opportunities and to take part in our Induction Programme. As part of our commitment to Safeguarding children, we provide in depth and ongoing training to cover all elements of Safeguarding, health and safety, medical training etc.

We are continually developing this role within the local community and especially with the local mainstream schools. A commitment to inclusive and outward looking practice in our school and local community is essential to this post.

- Two written references, who will be asked to comment on your suitability for working with our pupils. One of your references must be from your last employer and you are advised to seek referees from two different settings; one may be a character reference.
- An enhanced DBS check. The further responsibility to maintain the DBS update on an annual basis lies with the employee and you will be required to maintain your DBS update service while you are employed at our school.
- Evidence of your qualifications and proof of Identity. If qualifications have been awarded in another country, the certificates must be formally translated into English and independently verified that the translations are accurate.
