Purpose of the Role

- Assess, record, and report on pupils' progress, adapting teaching to meet individual needs.
- Have a commitment to strong, inclusive practice and raising standards across school.
- Create a positive classroom environment that promotes learning and good behaviour.
- Work collaboratively with colleagues to secure the best outcomes for children
- Ensure safeguarding and child protection policies are adhered to at all times.
- Participate in staff meetings, training, and school events as required.
- Take on a subject leadership role
- Demonstrate enthusiasm and commitment to support the wider life of school.

Teaching and Learning

- Deliver lessons that are engaging, creative and adapted to meet the needs of all pupils.
- Have a strong commitment to Quality First Teaching
- Develop and embed strong fundamental skills to prepare pupils for the next phase of their education.
- Have a commitment to providing regular outdoor learning opportunities.
- Use formative and summative assessment to inform planning and provision.
- Promote high expectations for all pupils, including those with SEND.
- Foster a love of learning and positive attitudes in pupils.

Classroom Management

- Ensure the classroom learning environment is safe, rich and enabling.
- Implement positive behaviour management strategies and consistent, high expectations for behaviour and learning
- Encourage independence and resilience in pupils.

Professional Development

- Be pro-active in engaging in continuous professional development.
- Reflect on practice and seek opportunities to improve teaching skills.
- Contribute to the wider life of the school.

Safeguarding

- Demonstrate commitment to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children.
- Follow school policies and procedures for child protection.
- Maintain confidentiality and professional boundaries.
