The Governing Body and Head Teacher wish to recruit a Teacher for SEND to support pupils with special educational needs and disabilities across our mainstream school, delivering targeted teaching and supporting staff to ensure pupils with SEND achieve positive outcomes.

**The successful candidate will:**

- Deliver targeted teaching and interventions for pupils with SEND.
- Plan and deliver teaching for pupils working on adapted learning pathways, including through frameworks such as SENIT Developmental Journals (DJ), AET approaches and EHCP outcomes.
- Work with the SEND team, including the SENDCo and SEND Lead Practitioner, and class teachers to support pupils with SEND, including those with EHCPs.
- Support pupils individually, in groups and across classes.
- Inspire and engage children in the learning process.
- Have a high level of communication skills and the ability to relate positively to children and adults.
- Be committed to our school and maintain effective relationships within our school community.
- Be committed to the happiness, wellbeing, self-esteem and progress of everyone at the school.
- Be willing to participate fully in the life of the school.
- Preferably be a practising Catholic or willing to support the ethos and practices of our Catholic school.
