JOB PURPOSE

To be responsible for teaching Key Stage 3 Art, GCSE Art and Art Photography, (currently AQA GCSE Photography: lens based and light based media). This will involve the monitoring of students' progress and performance to ensure that expected progress is achieved.

Duties and Responsibilities

1. To teach Art and Art Photography throughout the age and ability range as specified and according to the examination board requirements.
2. To plan and teach effectively to enable students to achieve and exceed expected progress, while following the agreed policies and procedures of the College.
3. To maintain an up-to-date knowledge and understanding of curricular requirements for Art and Art Photography.
4. To contribute to all aspects of work within the Faculty, ensuring that the teaching outcomes are successful (i.e. expected progress and better) in Art Photography and Art.
5. To be prepared to work as an important member of a team committed to teaching Art, developing resources and courses and to assist the Head of Faculty to ensure the successful running of the department.
6. To assist in the delivery of all qualifications offered by the Faculty and to have a secure knowledge and understanding of the subjects/curriculum areas and related pedagogy.
