Structure of the Faculty

The Business & Computing Faculty forms a small experienced, professional and well-motivated team maintaining high standards. We have a designated SLT line manager, excellent resources and regularly collaborate to strengthen our faculty. The Business and Computing curriculums are currently delivered through a carefully planned program of study, with guidance and support, we hope that every pupil can achieve the appropriate skills for the next stage of their lives.

The faculty supports links between Business and Computing and strong links to the Mathematics Faculty has developed a scheme of work where topics complement the common skills being developed. Business Curriculum

At KS4 currently we offer Pearson Edexcel GCSE Business Studies (IBS0) to pupils who opt to undertake the subject as an option over three hours a week for Year 10 and Year 11. At KS5 currently we offer Pearson Edexcel A-Level Business Studies (9BS0).

Computing Curriculum

At KS3 pupils have one hour of computing per week. All three year groups are taught in mixed ability. At KS4 currently we offer OCR GCSE Computer Science (J277) to pupils who opt to undertake the subject as an option over three hours a week for Year 10 and 11.
