- Mark student assessments, provide constructive feedback, and monitor progress.
- Use relevant attainment and behaviour data to support pupil progression.
- Communicate regularly with Heads of Department regarding pupil achievement.
- Participate in mentoring and intervention sessions when required.
- Contribute to departmental curriculum development in all relevant subjects.
- Support the development of cross-disciplinary learning where appropriate.
