STAFFING

The Computing and Business Faculty are a committed team of ICT, Computing and Business specialists who each contribute to our successful work within all Key Stages. We regularly share good practice, support each other and develop a range of teaching and learning strategies that fully exploit the potential new technologies have to offer. The team consists of 3 full-time members of staff including a Faculty Leader, a Subject Leader for Business Studies and a teacher of Computing.

COMPUTING CURRICULUM

Key Stage 3

When students join Hall Park Academy they have varied experiences of computing. We aim to establish and build on this prior knowledge. One lesson a week is taught in mixed ability groups with the emphasis on progressing beyond learning skills into a fuller understanding of the ideas and concepts behind the use of computers and their usage in the real world. This includes programming and computer Systems.

Key Stage 4

We currently offer GCSE OCR Computing. Two classes in Year 10 evidence it being very popular with many students opting for it year on year. Post-16 We currently offer A-Level ICT and A-Level Computing. Both courses are well established with many students opting for them year on year.

This secure area makes an excellent base for preparation and working with colleagues.
