- 5. be a competent and enthusiastic communicator of the subject to adults and students.
- 6. be aware of and responsive to current teaching developments within Dance and to have an overview and understanding of educational developments generally.
- 7. be aware of and responsive to all Health and Safety issues within Dance.
- 8. expect and be able to achieve appropriate standards of behaviour and discipline both within and outside the classroom.
- 9. work collaboratively within the Arts Department and with other members of staff in the school.
- be willing to accept and evaluate advice from subject and pastoral managers.
- 11. wish to promote and lead extra-curricular Dance activities including choreography for school shows and the annual dance show.
- 12. seek to establish/promote a successful professional career within the school.
- 13. be in sympathy with the ethos of the School and seek to uphold, develop and enhance the achievements and standards towards which the School works.
