Our Design Technology Team

Mayfield School are looking to appoint a dynamic Design Technology Teacher. The ideal candidate will have the ability to motivate and teach innovative lessons that are outstanding, engaging and raise both pupil progress and attainment alongside helping students to appreciate the subject and develop important skills and knowledge for life.

The successful candidate will offer a range of quality learning experiences both in and outside of the classroom through delivering extra-curricular clubs, sourcing suitable competitions for our learners to participate in, and setting challenging home learning tasks.

The faculty has an established team consisting of five specialist teachers and one technician. We are housed in a brand new state-of-the-art purpose-built building, which opened its doors for the first time in September 2020. The facilities consist of four workshops, one CAD / CAM room and a computer suite.

DT is a popular option at KS4, and product design at KS5 is a real niche allowing our students to apply for subject related degrees at university. Our current curriculum offer at KS3 includes delivering DT, food and textiles through a carousel that allows our learners to develop a variety of important life skills. At KS4 we offer GCSE DT, Textiles and Food preparation and nutrition. The DT faculty also has a longstanding relationship with the 'Faraday Challenge' and Accelerate Open-City. Currently we are delivering extra-curricular KS3 clubs in food and textiles.
