The Facilities

Each teacher has their own teaching base within the Faculty. There are three main Resistant Materials workshops, three Food rooms and two Textile classrooms. In addition there is a wide range of CAD/CAM equipment and two dedicated IT classroom with desktop computers for the faculty. Each room is equipped with a data projector.

The Team

The Technology team consists of five full time teachers and two part time teacher. We also have a two Technicians supporting both Resistant and Non-Resistant Materials.

Key Stage 3

Our KS3 curriculum is varied and exciting. Students have two hours of Technology each week, taught in mixed ability groups. They study Resistant Materials, Food, Textiles and Graphics throughout the Key Stage.

We are looking to once again develop strong links with our primary school partners in order to offer projects for Year 5 and Year 6 students.

Key Stage 4

At Key Stage 4 we offer GCSE courses in Design Technology, Graphic communication, Food Preparation and Nutrition, Hospitality and catering and Textiles. We also help support our vocational rout students providing them with four hours a fortnight developing practical skills in both cooking and Design Technology.

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
