Arts and Design Technology at The Bemrose School

The creative faculty consists of Art and Design, Music and Design and technology. We currently have four experienced specialist teachers delivering Design and Technology and 5 specialist teachers delivering Art and Music, supported by two technicians. The department is housed in a self-contained suite of specialist rooms. These include food, resistant materials, textiles, systems and control, music and art.

The department has seen an increase in modern resources over the last few years. These have included CAD/CAM machines for textiles and resistant materials, a suite of computers and bookable laptop trollies.

At KS4 students are able to opt for GCSE design and technology, specialising in either textiles or resistant materials and GCSE Art and Design. We also offer a course in hospitality and catering, for students wishing to study food at KS4, along with BTEC music.

The curriculum at both key stages has undergone significant change over the last few years. This has included an innovative new structure for delivering the KS3 curriculum.

We have strong links with a number of external partners including the University of Derby, Rolls Royce and the Derbyshire music hub.
