The Post

The Curriculum

Design Technology is a well-established and popular element of the curriculum at all Key Stages. In Year 9, all students study the whole range of Technology subjects on a basis of two lessons per week, split between the Department subjects.

Key Stage 4

At KS4, the Department offers Edexcel GCSE Design and Technology specification, split into two specialisms, Timbers and Paper & Board.

Key Stage 5

At KS5, the Department offers A Level Edexcel Product Design, which is very popular and over-subscribed.
