At KS3, all Creative Art subjects are largely practical and delivered over 2 periods per fortnight each. Uptake at KS4 is high across the Faculty compared to other schools and a range of qualifications are offered. Results are high in all subjects and we pride ourselves on our creativity.

The Faculty has a wide range of accommodation for teaching ranging from newly refurbished Music rooms (including Mac suite), purpose-built Drama Block with 2 professional standard Drama studios, a smaller older Drama studio, four specialist Art rooms including a Kiln room. Shows are regularly performed in the Drama Studios and our hall, which houses our Proscenium Arch Stage with permanent lighting and sound equipment.

The Faculty provides an extensive range of creative extra-curricular opportunities for students with numerous Art, Drama and Music clubs alongside the whole Faculty annual projects of the school Musical show and 'Spark' night. All 3 subject areas organise residential trips and/or cultural outings. Activities this year include Drama clubs, Pop Choir, Concert Band, and a variety Art Clubs. Our next school musical will be Bugsy Malone in November 2023.
