Matravers School is delighted to offer A Level Economics to pupils for the first time in 2026. The inclusion of Economics as part of our Sixth Form subject offer will strengthen the broad and diverse curriculum already available to pupils.

The introduction of a successful Economics A Level will complement our existing high performing courses, particularly in A Level Mathematics and L3 BTEC Business, as well as the wider humanities and social sciences. There is also the potential to include Economics as a GCSE within our Key Stage 4 curriculum offer.

Matravers is a higher performing school, with KS4 and A Level outcomes above national average attainment in 2025, in addition to A Level progress mid-points above national average in both 2024 and 2025.

The AQA A Level Economics specification has been promoted to pupils as part of the Sixth Form recruitment process. However, the successful candidate will have the opportunity to recommend their preferred specification and to discuss this with the Sixth Form team following their appointment.

The published entry requirements for A Level Economics are Grade 5s in both GCSE Maths and English.
