

The Business, Economics and Finance team currently comprises of four subject specialist staff who have a range of experience in education and private industry. The team are collaborative and supportive and share resources and lesson ideas as well as best practice from their own specialisms and experience. Lessons take place in two dedicated teaching rooms and two IT rooms where each member of staff is based.

The curriculum currently comprises of Edexcel Business GCSE and A level, Edexcel Economics and the outgoing LIBF Finance in year 13. There is also a fully-resourced personal finance course that is delivered to the whole of year 8 on rotation and which was new for 2024. All of the KS4 and KS5 courses are well established and resourced and achieve results that are significantly above the national average at KS4 and judged to be outstanding by ALPs each year in terms of progress. Our students progress to a range of higher apprenticeships and university courses including at Oxbridge and Russel Group universities where they often take Business, Economics or Finance-related courses.
