We are seeking to appoint for September 2025 a permanent teacher to join the English and Media Studies Department.

English groups are set by ability at Key Stage 3. Pupils study a range of texts within a variety of different genres. At Key Stage 4, students follow the AQA GCSE English Language and Literature specifications. The three A Levels offered at Key Stage 5 are English Language, English Literature and Media Studies.

Responsible to: in the first instance, the Head of English and ultimately to the Headteacher.

Duties will include:

English Department:

- Contributing to the teaching of the KS3, KS4 and KS5 English and Media Studies courses where appropriate
- The planning and preparation of lessons together with associated homework to meet the needs of all learners
- Monitoring and supporting the progress of students in designated classes
- The regular marking of work and assessment and record keeping in accordance with school and departmental policies
- Keeping up to date with changes in the English curriculum and where appropriate Media Studies
- Undertaking such responsibilities within the department as the Head of Department may reasonably require.

Whole School:

- Attendance at Staff Meetings, Pastoral, Curriculum Development meetings and Parents' Evenings
- Attendance at statutory In-Service training days and twilight sessions
- Supporting the implementation of whole-school policies in areas such as behaviour, safeguarding, homework and health and safety
- Undertaking appropriate pastoral responsibilities as required
- Participation in the School's arrangements for performance management
- Undertaking the duties of a Form Tutor with a year based tutor group
- Such other duties as the Headteacher may reasonably require.
