Job Responsibilities include:

- To identify and track the progress of the most able pupils across key stages three and four
- To work with departments to ensure that the most able pupils make excellent progress across the curriculum.
- To report on the progress of the most able cohort at termly key stage achievement board meetings.
- To deliver CPD to ensure that teachers are fully equipped to meet the needs of the most able cohort.
- To work with the Oxbridge coordinator to co-ordinate students, year 7-13, to inspire them to have high aspirations and apply to Oxbridge/Russell group universities.
- To develop and lead a programme of support to stretch and challenge the most able pupils in year 7-13 inclusive
- To take students, year 7-13 to Oxbridge and other leading universities
- To work alongside faculty leads and the careers lead to organise talks, master classes and seminars which will inspire the most able year 7-13
