The successful applicant will be:

1. An excellent classroom practitioner, with QTS status, - one who utilises a range of successful teaching methodologies, but also someone who is also open to new ideas, and who is willing and able to share these strategies with others.
2. Someone with an enthusiasm for teaching modern foreign languages, and who is able to convey and communicate that enthusiasm to pupils of all ages.
3. Someone who is ambitious; will be willing to take extra responsibility when the need arises, and who is looking to develop their career further.
4. Someone who can work well in a team, and can share ideas both informally and formally.
5. Someone who knows when to stop, relax and say 'no' in a difficult and demanding job.
6. A practitioner with excellent classroom management skills, to deliver differentiated schemes of work to challenge and enable all pupils to develop to their full potential;
