Humanities is a forward thinking and hardworking Faculty. The team of staff employed within Humanities are a strong unit, very supportive of each other and welcoming of new staff. At KS3, members of the curriculum area can teach across the range of subjects we offer which are: History, Geography and Ethics and Philosophy (EP). As a result, lessons are structured to enable non-specialists to feel confident with students being encouraged to learn through enquiry based lessons.

There is good access to ICT with the Faculty owning 2 laptop trolleys and having a designated ICT room. Textbooks and other resources are constantly being updated and evaluated.

This position offers an excellent opportunity for an experienced candidate to further develop their skills in a large and successful faculty. It also offers less experienced candidates, including NQTs, an excellent opportunity to develop, with the potential to teach KS5 Geography for the right candidate.

Geography is a popular GCSE and A Level option with 5 groups in the current Y9 cohort, 3 groups in Y10, 3 in Y11 and 1 group in both Y12 and Y13. At KS4 we teach the AQA specification and at A level we follow the Edexcel specification. There are 5 members in the department which include a mixture of new and experienced staff. Fieldwork is an important element of the curriculum including a trip to Flamborough Head at KS3, trips to Burbage Brook and Sheffield at KS4 and Manchester and the Holderness Coast at KS5. We also run an overseas trip to the Bay of Naples, Italy.
