Computing Curriculum

Key Stage 3

Students arrive at Ruskin Priory with a varied experience of Computing and we aim to establish and build on prior knowledge. Students have one lesson a week where we cover the KS3 National Curriculum, which includes programming using Scratch and Python, Understanding Computers and Computational thinking.

Key Stage 4

Students are able to opt for GCSE Computer Science (AQA) and/or Creative I-Media (OCR). In Year 10 they are taught 5 hours over 2 weeks and in Year 11 they are taught 6 hours over 2 weeks.

Key Stage 5

Students are able to opt for Cambridge Technical Digital Media Level 3. In Year 12 and 13 they are taught 10 hours over 2 weeks.
